DESCRIPTION: Our Pinot Noir comes from distinct vineyards throughout Oregon. We look for sites that give us diversity, low elevation for ripeness and intensity, high elevation for acidity and aromatics. From Walla Walla to Dundee to Melrose, Oregon, these sites allow us to create this truly Oregon Pinot Noir.

TASTING NOTES: The Underwood Pinot Noir exhibits aromas of red raspberries, Bing cherries and notes of char and baking spice. The palate is filled with sweet raspberry and cherry fruits with warm cocoa tones. This wine's brightness and fine tannins come together in a fruit laden finish.
