

When Ryan Harms started Union Wine Company in 2005, he did so with the goal of creating Oregon wines that could be widely accessible to wine drinkers, without sacrificing quality. Underwood exemplifies this commitment and draws from the diverse palette of vineyards and wine-growing regions that Oregon offers to create approachable everyday drinking wine of exceptional value.

We believe the contents are more important than the container, and good wine should be able to go anywhere. Underwood cans have you covered without sacrificing great taste and craftsmanship. #pinkiesdown Underwood Pinot Gris is composed from fruit sources in the Willamette, Umpqua and Applegate Valleys. The fruit was thoughtfully picked at various intervals in the latter half of September through October to create a blend that is generous with its aromatics and fruit, yet focused, with acidity start to finish. We press, overnight-settle, and ferment the juice in stainless steel tanks to retain the pretty aromatics of this wine.
