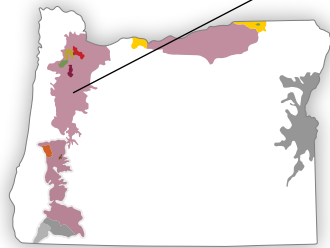

The 2022 Rose Bubbles is two-thirds Pinot Noir and roughly a third Pinot Gris. Both grown and harvested intentionally for bubbles, the grapes for the Rose Bubbles were picked at the turning point from bright grapefruit notes to red raspberry. Pressed, settled, fermented at cool temperatures, and stopped with a smidge over 11 g/L residual sugar remaining, this wine is truly mouth-watering.
